COOPERATIVE SPONSORSHIP(S) APPROVED

Armstrong/Apollo Ridge – Varsity Wrestling

The BOD accepted the request from Apollo Ridge High School and Armstrong High School to form a cooperative sponsorship of a sport agreement in varsity wrestling beginning the 2018-2019 school year with Armstrong as the host school.

Bishop Canevin/Carlynton – Boys & Girls Track & Field

The BOD accepted the request from Bishop Canevin High School and Carlynton High School to form a cooperative sponsorship of a sport agreement in varsity boys and girls track and field beginning the 2018-2019 school year with Carlynton as the host school.

SCHOOL RELATED ACTIONS

Penn Hills ~ Football Team's Use of a Smoke Devices

The BOD publicly censured the administration and football coaching staff; probated the football program for one year through November 23, 2019; the coaching staff must successfully complete an ACEP class prior to June 1, 2019; and the football team will be prohibited from participating in the 2019-2020 post season unless the head football coach is suspended for the first game of the 2019-2020 season for the team's use of smoke devices at the 2018 WPIAL 5A championship game at Norwin High School on November 23, 2018.

Vincentian Academy – Ineligible Student Athlete

The BOD publicly censured the administration and head boy's basketball coach and are limited to only one scrimmage for the 2019-2020 basketball season for letting a student athlete participate before receiving WPIAL BOD approval.

ELIGIBILITY HEARINGS

California – Malik Ramsey

After considering the information and testimony presented at the hearing on November 19, 2018, the BOD denied the request to permit Malik Ramsey post-season eligibility in basketball under Article VI, Section 2B of the PIAA By-Laws.

Ellwood City – Jarrett Johnson

After reviewing the information and testimony presented at the hearing on November 19, 2018 regarding the transfer of Jarrett Johnson from Mohawk High School to Ellwood City High School, the WPIAL BOD declined to grant eligibility in basketball only for a period of one year from the date of transfer of August 22, 2018 under Article VI, Section 4C of the PIAA By-Laws.
